Ordinances and Legal Notices for the Village of Payne

The Mayor and Council of the Village of Payne would like to inform the Residents and visitors of Payne of several Ordinances and Legal Notices

Ordinances:

2015-16: An Ordinance Providing for the removal of all motor vehicles from all streets, public highways, parking lots and alleys within the Village of Payne, Paulding County, Ohio when two (2) or inches of snow has fallen.

This Ordinance mandates that if two (2) inches of snow have fallen vehicles are to be removed from the streets, alleys, highways and parking lot of the Village of Payne, so the snow may be removed. Vehicles will be towed at the owner's expense and owner may be fined up to \$100.00. This ordinance was passed on 11/23/2015 and is now enforceable. This Ordinance also allows for Declaration of Snow Emergencies when advance predictions of heavy snow fall is forecasted.

2015-17: An Ordinance Establishing snow emergency regulations for the Village of Payne, Paulding County, Ohio; providing for the removal of motor vehicles during a snow emergency.

This Ordinance provides that when 2 inches of snow has fallen within the Village no motor vehicles maybe parked on streets, alleys, highways, and parking lots within the Village until snow fall has stopped and roadways are cleared for travel. This Ordinance was adopted on 11/23/2015 and is now enforceable.

2015-18: An Ordinance prohibiting the removal of snow from the sidewalks, driveways, parking lots and alleys and depositing same on the streets and public highways within the Village of Payne.

This Ordinance prohibits any residents from removing snow from your property and depositing into the roadway. Violation of this ordinance carries a \$25.00 fine. This ordinance was passed on 11/25/2015 and in now enforceable.

2015-15: An Ordinance regulating and prohibiting the discarding of yard waste into the streets and public highways within the Village of Payne.

This ordinance prohibits residents from disposing of grass, leaves, sticks and any other yard debris into the streets as it blocks the storm drains. This ordinance is a misdemeanor of the fourth degree and any violators will be fined \$250.00 for each violation. This ordinance was passed on 12/14/2015 and is enforceable at this time.

Legal Notice:

The Village of Payne will be enforcing Sections 320.04.g.4 and 325.04.g.4 which states: Automotive vehicles or trailers of any kind or type without current license plates shall not be parked or stored on any residentially zoned property other than in completely enclosed buildings. However, one boat and one travel trailer may be stored in the rear/side yard if they have a current license.
